



**Town of Mulgrave
Meeting Minutes
June 7, 2021**

4. New Business/Carry Forward Business

a. Community Infrastructure Projects

The Department of Municipal Affairs has launched its 2021-2022 funding applications for 5 categories of projects:

- Provincial Capital Assistance Program (PCAP)
- Flood Risk Infrastructure Investment Program (FRIIP)
- Municipal Innovation Program (MIP)
- Beautification and Streetscaping Program (BSP)
- Community Works Program

Deadline for applications is June 29, 2021. The Beautification and Streetscaping Application will be submitted shortly (see b. below). The CAO will discuss potential projects in the remaining categories with the Public Works Supervisor, and Councillors are encouraged to forward any suggestions to the CAO for inclusion in the application process.

b. Beautification and Streetscaping Program

Council thanked Finance Administration Clerk, Jenna Walker for her work in preparing the Beautification and Streetscaping Program application. The application includes the addition of banners and poles along Main Street, construction of a kiosk for a Town map and bulletin board, the addition of two gazebos (one in each park) to allow park users to shelter from the sun, as well as park and boardwalk repairs. Total cost of the project is estimated to be over \$31,000, and the Program will fund up to 50% of eligible project costs.

c. Plebiscite

On April 6, 2021 the following motion was passed:

Council schedule a plebiscite for the *Keeping of Farm Animals Within Town Limits*, subject to regulations from the Province of Nova Scotia.




